



4WD Course

General Course info:

The aim of this course is to encourage the responsible use of a light 4WD vehicle, to understand the legal requirements, and to encourage safer 4WD practices in both the workplace and for recreational purposes. The course, as required, can be tailored to meet the specific needs of the client as it relates to terrain composition (eg sand, rock, mud, clay etc), 4WD hazards, ascents, failures, descents, tobogganing, rollover, regaining traction, water crossings, 4WD equipment, recovery, and any additional needs a client may wish to cover.

At the conclusion of each course component a candidate can expect to be assessed in terms of their in any, or all of the following national unit standards:

17976 –Theory of 4WD Operation
17978 –Operate a Light 4WD Off-Road
20848 –Operate a Light 4WD On-Road

Elective unit standards: 17676 –Pre-drive checks on a light motor vehicle
17977 –Develop a plan for an off-road journey

Duration: 2 days

Pre-requisite: New Zealand Full Class 1 Drivers License.

Prices: Pricing for the 4WD course will depend on whether Cornerstone Training and Management Services Ltd can access Government funding in support of the clients training cost. If funding is available then the following will also apply:

A training candidate will be required to provide either (1) confirmation of New Zealand, Tokolauan, Nuiean, Cook Island or Australian citizenship via one of the following; a copy of their birth cert, passport, or Statement of Whakapapa (signed by the Kaumatua and detailing parentage, place and date of birth), or (2) provide evidence of permanent residency via a copy of their residency passport stamp (to include copy of personal details page) or residency letter from Immigration.

Funding can not be provided if a trainee is enrolled in school or if another Government organisation is paying for the course on behalf of them e.g. Work and Income.

Please note: That should all trainee(s) be eligible for funding they will be enrolled as part of a certificate agreed with a Industry Training Organisation or a Polytechnic programme/course. The account for the training will however be administered by Cornerstone Industry Training Limited. If any of the trainee(s) are not eligible for funding they will still have their qualifications posted on the NZQA Framework by Cornerstone Training and Management Services Ltd.
