



## ATV Course

### General Course info:

The aim of this course is to encourage responsible and productive use of an All Terrain Vehicle (ATV), to understand the legal requirements and to encourage safer ATV practices in both the workplace and for recreational purposes. ATV's are one of the biggest killers and causes of "Lost Time Injuries" within agriculture and general industry. ATV's are notoriously prone to roll-overs, with their high centre-of-gravity combined with their sheer weight, makes an ATV very dangerous to an untrained operator. This course covers the hazards, the means to overcome these hazards and how to productively operate an ATV within it's Centre-of-Gravity boundaries.

Each course component will conclude with the candidate being assessed as to their competency against and one, or all of the following unit standards:

- 24557, Demonstrate knowledge of safe operation of an ATV
- 24554, Ride an ATV on flat terrain (0°-15°)
- 24559, Ride an ATV on undulating terrain (15°-35°)
- 24561, Ride an ATV with trailed equipment
- 24563, Ride an ATV with mounted equipment or a load

Duration: 1 to 3 days depending on experience and may be divided into basic and advanced sessions.

Pre-requisite: Class 6 full licence for ATV over 250cc, or Class 6 Learner for ATV under 250cc. No Licence is required if 80% of use is in an off road environment

Access to your own ATV for course purposes. It is preferred that candidate's are trained on their own ATV however, the vehicle must be in a legal and safe condition before it can be used for training purposes. If the candidate does not have an ATV, we can arrange hireage for you at a price of \$120 per ATV for the day.

Prices: Pricing for the ATV course will depend on whether Cornerstone Training and Management Services Ltd can draw Government funding in support of reducing the cost to the client. If funding is available then the following will also apply.

Should funding be available the trainee must provide; confirmation of New Zealand, Tokolauan, Nuiean, Cook Island or Australian citizenship via one of the following; 1) a copy of their birth cert, passport, or Statement of Whakapapa (signed by the Kaumatua and detailing parentage, place and date of birth), or 2) provide evidence of permanent residency via a copy of their residency passport stamp (to include copy of personal details page) or residency letter from the NZ Immigration Department. Funding will not be available to a trainee if 1) the training is enrolled in school, or 2) if another government organisation is paying for the course on the trainee's behalf e.g. Work and Income, or 3) appropriate evidence of citizenship or residency is not produced.

*Please note: That should all trainee(s) be eligible for funding they will be enrolled on a Polytechnic course. If any of the trainee(s) are not eligible for funding they will be charged a full cost recovery rate while those that are eligible will still be enrolled with the polytechnic.*
