



CHAINSAW COURSE

General Course Info:

Chainsaws are a labour saving aid used by many New Zealanders' such as farmers, firewood gatherers, home handy-people, orchardists and forestry workers etc. While a chainsaw is a useful tool in a variety of situations it is also a dangerous piece of equipment that, if not used or maintained correctly, can cause serious and debilitating injuries. This chainsaw course is designed for the casual user of chainsaws and focuses on the following factors:

- Practices and hazards associated with the safe use of chainsaws
- Maintaining chainsaws
- Operating techniques when using chainsaws
- The Code of Practice relating to chainsaw use

At the conclusion of each component of the course candidates can expect to be assessed on their knowledge against the following national unit standards:

- Unit standard 6916, Demonstrate knowledge of the Code of Practice relating to chainsaw use
- Unit standard 6917, Operate a chainsaw

Duration: 2 full days

Clothing & Equipment: Trainees will need steel capped footwear and sturdy clothing

Prices: Pricing for the Chainsaw course depends on whether Cornerstone Training and Management Services Ltd, can draw Government funding in support of the client costs. Should funding be available the following will apply:

The candidate will be required to provide either; (1) confirmation of New Zealand, Tokolauan, Nuiean, Cook Island or Australian citizenship via one of the following; a copy of their birth cert, passport, or Statement of Whakapapa (signed by the Kaumatua and detailing parentage, place and date of birth), or (2) provide evidence of permanent residency via a copy of their residency passport stamp (to include copy of personal details page) or residency letter from Immigration. Funding can not be provided if a candidate is enrolled in school or if another government organisation is paying for the course on behalf of them e.g. Work and Income.

Please note: That should all candidate(s) be eligible for funding they will be enrolled on a Polytechnic course. If any of the candidate(s) are not eligible for funding those that are, will still be enrolled with the polytechnic.
