



TREE FELLING COURSE

General Course Info:

Given the serious nature and dangers associated with tree felling this course is designed to provide appropriate knowledge and practice for the efficient and safe felling of trees. Successful trainees will qualify on the following unit standards:

- Unit standard 17763, Demonstrate knowledge of Tree Felling
- Unit standard 17766, Fell trees safely using a chainsaw and basic techniques

Course Content:

- Safety factors and hazards associated with felling trees
- Equipment and use during tree felling activities
- Tree felling techniques and site clearance
- demonstrate knowledge of the use of chainsaws while felling trees
- demonstrate knowledge of personal safety before, during and after the felling of trees
- Fell trees (at least 20 trees). If this requirement can not be met, or the trainee does not meet the appropriate criteria, then the trainee can only qualify on unit standard 17763. Follow-up arrangements should then be made to complete the felling requirement at a later date to achieve competency in unit standard 17766.

Duration: 2 full days

Clothing & Equipment: Trainees will need steel capped footwear and sturdy clothing, ear muffs, safety helmet

Prices: Pricing for the Tree Felling course depends on whether Cornerstone Training and Management Services Ltd, can draw Government funding on the trainees behalf or not.

If funding is available the trainee must provide; confirmation of New Zealand, Tokolauan, Nuiean, Cook Island or Australian citizenship via one of the following; a copy of their birth cert, passport, or Statement of Whakapapa (signed by the Kaumatua and detailing parentage, place and date of birth); or provide evidence of permanent residency via a copy of their residency passport stamp (to include copy of personal details page) or residency letter from Immigration. Funding can not be provided if a trainee is enrolled in school or if another government organisation is paying for the course on behalf of them e.g. Work and Income.

Please note: That should all trainee(s) be eligible for funding they will be enrolled on a Polytechnic course. If any of the trainee(s) are not eligible for funding they will be charged a full cost recovery rate that will be advised on request. Remaining eligible trainees will still be enrolled with the polytechnic.
